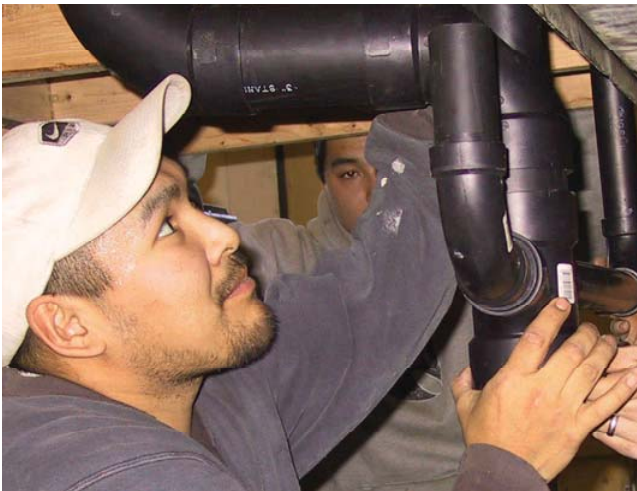

Plumbers work with various materials and fixtures used in the installation, maintenance, removal, and alteration of plumbing systems.

Pipefitters fabricate and install high-pressure piping systems, including heating, oil, and gas systems, in addition to the installation of boilers, generators, etc.

To qualify, you must be 18 or older and drug free. You must submit a complete application and copies of:

- Birth Certificate (proof that you are 18 or older)
- High School Diploma or GED
- Transcripts and/or GED Test Scores
- Valid Alaska Driver's License
- DD214 for veterans

Additional documents recommended:

- Letters of Recommendation
- Training Certificates
- Cover Letter
- Resume
